



Skin Care during Menopause Period

Menopause period is a specific time in a woman's life. It is a normal part of aging and marks the end of reproductive years.

There are 3 stages of natural menopause;

- 1. **Perimenopause:** It is the time when the ovaries gradually produce less estrogen and can start 8 to 10 years before menopause. In the last 1 to 2 years of perimenopause, the drop in estrogen accelerates. At this stage, many women may experience menopause symptoms.
- 2. **Menopause:** It is the point when a woman no longer has menstrual periods which typically occurs in the late 40s to early 50s. At this stage, the woman's ovaries stop producing the hormones estrogen and progesterone.
- 3. **Postmenopause:** It is the stage after menopause. During postmenopause, many of the symptoms women experienced during perimenopause and menopause may discontinue.

Decreasing in hormone level can cause many skin problems. Skin loses some ability to hold water inducing dehydration and dryness. Moreover, deeper lines, wrinkles, sagging skin, swollen eyes and puffiness are noticed because of less production of collagen and elastin. At this age, women's skin become more sensitive and unbalanced.

Women can relieve some of the skin-related effects by using the proper skin care regimen.

Cleanser: As the skin gets drier, cleansing foam or gel with moisturizing effect will be the suitable formula.

Moisturizer: Use emollient-rich moisturizer on the face and neck every day, and look for skin care products designed to fight fine lines, wrinkles and sagging skin.

Sunscreen: Skin may have low natural protection. It is recommended to use a broad-spectrum with high SPF sunscreen product to ensure the skin is protected against UV rays.

Regulations

Thai Regulation for Use of Amino Acids as Active Ingredients in Food Supplements (Finale)

The annex of active ingredients as amino acids in food supplements is as follows. This regulation came into force on October 19, 2006.

No.	Name of variety of amino acids and their forms	Maximum level for recommended daily intake (mg)
14	Taurine	NMT 3000 ³
15	L-tyrosine	NMT 700¹ (calculated as L-tyrosine) or combined use with phenylalanine total amount shall not be more than 700¹ (calculated as combination of L-tyrosine and L-Phenylalanine)
16	L-ornithine or L-ornithine hydrochloride or L-ornithine aspartate	NMT 500² (calculated as L-ornithine)
