2. Straight Lines




Black or neon graphic lines drawn over eyes were spotted at many stages.

4. Get Cheeky with It




Heavy pigmented blusher and/or bronzer are used to brush and contour the face.

The Check List of Documents Needed for Notification of Cosmetic Containing "Part of Marijuana or Part of Hemp"



1. All side labels on sale products

Display warning "The product may cause allergies or irritation" and "If any abnormalities occur after use, discontinue using and consult a doctor or pharmacist."



2. Certificate from the Director of the Company to certify that

- 2.1 Part of marijuana or part of hemp used as an ingredient in cosmetics is obtained from the country.
- 2.2 Contaminated THC amount in the finished product does not exceed 0.2 % w/w.
- 2.3 Product properties are not described beyond the scope of cosmetics.



The Check List of Documents Needed for Notification of Cosmetic Containing Terpenes Derived from Marijuana or Hemp



1. The document indicated source of TERPENES

of TERPENES such as Specification or MSDS of terpenes.



2. All side labels on sale products



3. Certificate from the Director of the Company

to certify that contaminated THC amount in the finished product does not exceed 0.2 %w/w.


DCAC Webinar, Indonesia (Jakarta)
